- 1 This Request for Expression of Interest follows the General Procurement Notice dated 11/03/2016 published in World Bank web site on Preparation of the Transport Connectivity and Asset Management Project (TCAMP).
- 2 The Government of Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka (GOSL) has received a loan from the World Bank towards the cost of TCAMP and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to finance the consultancy assignments for "*International Road Assessment Program (iRAP) Assessments of Road Network*".
- 3 Under this assignment, the Road Development Authority (RDA) desires the Consultant to carry out the systematic Assessment of Road Safety Levels of National Highways through a pilot project using **International Road Assessment Program (iRAP)** approach and associated software tools (Vida), for 1170km of roads, and build internal capacity of RDA to sustain this approach for undertaking assessment of road safety levels of all National Highways & Expressways over the medium and long-term.
- 4 The Road Development Authority (RDA), the implementing agency of TCAMP now invites Expression of Interest from eligible consultants internationally, with proven track records on conducting similar IRAP Assessment assignments for national roads to indicate their interest in providing the aforesaid services as IRAP Assessment Consultant.
- 5 This Contract is for iRAP assessments of 1170 km of RDA roads and shall be of 15 months duration. Thereafter, Network Planning and Road Safety Division, RDA will carry these assessments for the balance National Highway and Expressway network of RDA.
- 6 Interested Consultants shall provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform these services in the prescribed formats.
